
Obey the Word

When I am afraid, I will put my trust and faith in You (Psalm 56:3)

The key to overcoming your fear is trusting God, PERIOD. The Apostle Paul led a fearless life, he stated, "For I am convinced [and continue to be convinced—beyond any doubt] that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present and threatening, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, will be able to separate us from the [unlimited] love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord" (<u>Romans 8:38-39</u>). Are you convinced? If not, you should spend more time in the Word. Use self-talk. Meditate on the goodness of God. If you can think of times in your life or the lives of others when God showed up, meditate on those times. David encouraged himself by remembering how he killed the lion and the bear.

How do you overcome fear and the lies of the enemy? By the Word of your testimony and the blood of Jesus which cleanses you of all sin.

Confession: The fear of man brings a snare, But whoever trusts in and puts his confidence in the Lord will be exalted and safe.
